This trial is outdoors on grass. Please bring your own shade. This is a public park – tents and crates may be left overnight at your own risk.

Entry Limits:

400 Runs/day

Move ups:

Move-ups are allowed from day to day. If you finish a title and want to move up before the trial, email andrea@allamericandogsports.com by October 19, 2026

Day of show Entries:

We will accept day of trial entries if the trial does not fill. The day of trial entry fees will be \$15.00 per class with no packages.

Refunds:

Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date for any reason other than bitches in heat. There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or a handler are dismissed from competition regardless of reason for such dismissal. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. The organizing committee may refuse any entry as provided through NADAC rules and regulations. Anyone not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry in the trial.

If you are experiencing symptoms of or test positive for COVID-19, please notify us and we will withdraw and refund your entry

Preliminary confirmations will be sent within a week of receiving your entry. Final confirmations will be sent once the trial has closed. Please read over your confirmations carefully. We will be happy to make corrections if notified prior to the final move up date. A Worker Sign Up board will be posted near the ring. Remember, the Worker Schedule must be filled out before each class can begin. Thank you in advance for the generous contribution of your time and energy!

Awards and Ribbons:

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st thru 4th place in each jump height (except Chances, which is pass/fail.) Qualifiers will receive a rosette. Anyone who achieves their NATCH at the trial will receive a special NATCH ribbon. Customizable New Title, New Award, and Debut rosettes are also available.

Special HIT Awards: This year we are also offering High in Trial rosettes based on total Q points (excluding Sunday's tunnelers runs), for small (4-8") Medium (12") and Large (16-20") dogs. We will also have an end-of-the-year *High in Series* customized award encompassing the April, October, and New Years trials.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. New Handlers please register here: [NADAC-New Handler-Dog Registration](#). If you already have a dog registered with NADAC or are a NADAC Associate, please visit the H&D Portal to register a new dog.
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (zip-lock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5.
